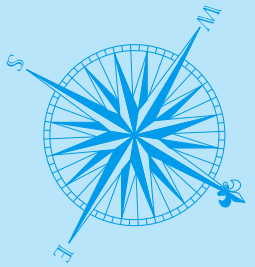

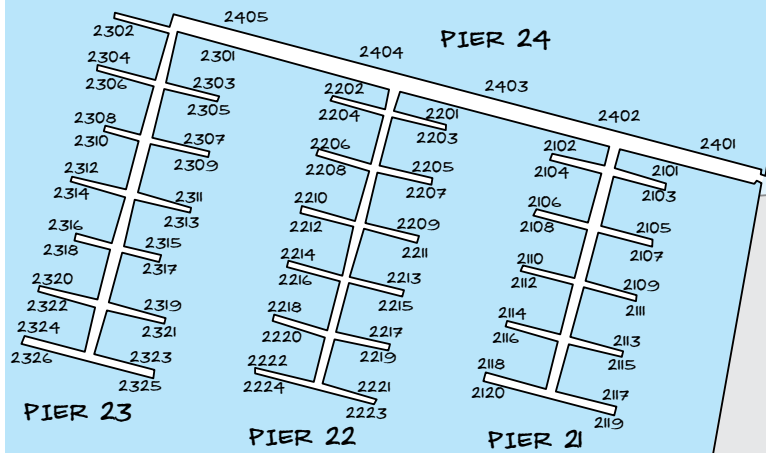

Restroom & Gate code

There are three sets of restrooms and showers available on the Marina grounds. The first set is located in the main Marina building, directly under the Famous Dave's sign. The second set is located adjacent to the Picnic shelter near the end of the transient dock walkway. The third set is near the Marina pool and laundry room.

To gain access to a restroom or thru the Pier 11 gate, there is a keypad located adjacent to the door. The four digit access code below will open the restrooms and gate for the entire length of your stay. After entering the four digit code, press the * key and the green light will come on. You then have 10 seconds to open the door without having to re-enter the code.

Public restrooms are located on the south side of the Transient Restrooms. These restrooms are not locked, have no shower facilities and are open 24 hours a day.

Welcome to the Cedar Point Marina

The staff of the Cedar Point Marina welcomes you and wants to make your stay here a safe and enjoyable experience for you and your family. To achieve this, we ask that you look over the following set of guidelines. Should you have any questions, please feel free to ask any of our staff members for help.

- ONE electrical outlet is available per dock. 50 foot docks have ONE 50 amp 250 volt outlet per dock. 30 & 40 foot docks have ONE 30 amp 125 volt outlet per dock. The Marina Office rents out a limited number of 50 amp adapters.
- Quiet hours are appreciated between the hours of 11:00 pm and 8:00 am.
- State law does not permit the consumption of alcohol in the parking lot or any other public area in the Marina. Alcohol may be consumed on your boat or your dock only.
- If you have guests arriving by car, there will be a Cedar Point parking fee. In and out passes for the vehicles are not available. Campers, trailers and recreational vehicles are not permitted in the Marina parking lot. There is parking available for these vehicles on the south side of our service facility.
- Your pets are welcomed at the Cedar Point Marina if kept leashed at all times and they must be kept on your boat. For your convenience there are two dog walk areas in the Marina, and a Pet Chek boarding kennel located next to Pier 8. Pets are not permitted in any of the grassy areas of the Marina.
- Grills or open flames on your boat or dock are not permitted at any time. You may grill in the picnic area near Pier 8. There are charcoal grills located in that area.
- The Marina is not responsible for loss or damage to articles left on your boat or the premises.
- Any use of firearms or fireworks is strictly prohibited.

FOR YOUR SAFETY

**In the event of an emergency, DIAL 911 on any pay phone in the Marina.
This will put you in contact with the Cedar Point Police Department.**

- Please keep the docks clear of any possible trip hazards. (i.e. water hoses, electrical cords, chairs, etc.)
- Swimming, fishing or wind surfing is not permitted in the Cedar Point Harbor. The Cedar Point beach or the Marina pool and spa are available. A courtesy van is available for transportation to Hotel Breaker's beach. The Marina pool is located near Pier 5 next to the Bay Harbor Restaurant.
- No bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller skates or roller blades may be operated on Cedar Point property.
- Maximum speed of any vessel in the Marina is three (3) mph. Dinghies and personal watercraft may be operated in the Marina but must be operated below the three mph speed limit.
- Docks may be slippery when wet or dry. Please do not run on piers.
- Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children.
